Prayer Shawl Ministry



We now average over 40,000 suicides a year in America. And, for every successful suicide, there are 12 or more failed attempts. Let's break that down—just in America, every minute of the day, 24/7, someone takes their life or attempts to. That's how bad depression and anxiety can get.

Depression and anxiety have many faces—major depression, bipolar disorder, panic disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder, social phobias, post-traumatic stress disorder, among others. The world today is laden with uncertainty and fear. Global unrest, war, unclear financial futures and a high-tech accelerated pace of living contribute to a fertile breeding ground for anxiety and depression.

Despite these facts, take some comfort that there is help in all of these diagnosis. And most of all, remember that God loves you and wants you well. God's unfailing love for us is an objective fact affirmed over and over in the scriptures. It originates in the very nature of God, who is love, and it flows to us through our union with Jesus Christ.

Your HOPE team at Our Savior's is working hard to be more visible and helpful for people struggling with a mental illness. Let's help end the stigma associated with mental illness.
