OSLC Security System Update

The security system at OSLC is officially set to go into full effect October 1st 2019. **IMPORTANT REMINDER:** This system has been put into place to keep us and our worship space safe. The safety and security team is doing everything they can to make this necessary change as easy as possible. Please never hesitate to ask questions! What you need to know:

- The church office hours are Monday- Thursday 8 am-4 pm, Fri 8 am-Noon. Access to the building is available during these hours by ringing the bell and waiting for assistance.
- For all church services, the elevator entrance door will automatically unlock 30 minutes before service, and it will automatically lock 15 mins after service begins.
- The office wing will be locked, meaning both of the doors to the office wing are locked, and the office wing will not be accessible, except by key or code on weekends.
- Wrench keys will be removed from all entrances, eliminating the option to force a door to remain unlocked. Doors are not ever to be propped open.
- The old key pad and code will be disabled.
- If you have a group that meets outside the times outlined, or if you require access to the office wing, please see Kasey Konkle, office manager. She will assist you with acquiring a building access code.
- All persons with access to the building will be required to sign a Building Access Agreement.

All of this will go into full effect OCTOBER 1st. Please take time over the next couple weeks to get your questions answered, and if you require access to our building, Kasey is happy to assist you with setting that up.
