Council Meeting Minutes October 13, 2020 – 7:00 p.m.

<u>Open Forum – 2021 Budget Presentation – Tim Moe:</u>

Expect member giving to increase (~\$15,000) because building fund will be paid off May 2021.

Expenses will increase due to salary and health care costs.

Fixed budget – 92-95% of budget goes to salary, benevolence, office/general, and building & grounds.

Income expected \$420,000 (increase from 2020)

For 2020, expenses are \$436,000 and income expected is \$413,000 which will be a deficit of \$23,000. We do have \$104,000 in reserve (not accounted for in budget).

Not included in next year's budget but programs to consider are: 1) Starting intern program – \$36,000, 2) Technology consultant, and 3) Add staff member to help with outreach program

Motion/Second/Carried Schultz/Terry to approve the 2021 budget. All voting aye.

Pastor's Report:

Parking lot/drive-in service (10 on Sat. and 30 on Sun.). Next service is Oct 24-25 then weekly after that.

Every member calling going on right now.

COVID-19 Rise Again Team – Agreed to pull back right now.

Baptism this weekend - masks required.

Colleen Welsh will be leaving her position at the end of this year.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u>: September income was lower than previous months. Staff expenses and benevolence higher. Month short by \$14,012.

Ministry Team Reports:

Retirees and Friends – Joan Terry: Looking at sending out care packages.

Evangelism, Marketing, Communication & Technology: Kevin Schabo: Reached out to group members to see who plans to continue on this team.

<u>Finance – Sue Schultz/Marcie Kimmes</u>: Working on budget and Stewardship plan.

<u>Learn and Grow/Youth - Chris Crum</u>: Trying to figure out how to handle confirmation and first communion this fall.

<u>Personnel – Sue Schultz</u>: Reviews going well and updating job descriptions. Pastor excused at 8:11 so council could discuss next year's health insurance proposal (change from Silver C to Gold plan) and cost of living increase (revised based on Social Security COLA increase of 1.3%). **Motion/Second/Carried Schultz/Terry to approve new health insurance plan and salary increase**. All voting aye

<u>Serve and Reach – TBD:</u> Pam Garman running committee – Chili To Go. Will not be donating Christmas hams to the Brigade this year. They are looking for financial support instead.

<u>Worship and Music – Graham Bradley</u>: Was working on planning in-person service which is now on hold. Looking at a virtual choir.

New Business:

<u>Knudsen Island Shores Request</u>: Island Shores is looking to start up a Vesper service again. Pastor is going to reach out to the Knudsens and Island Shores to see how he can help.

<u>Council Officers and Nominations for New Council Members</u>: Kevin Schabo agreed to serve another term. Chris Crum is done this year and Andrew Schaller resigned leaves 2 spots to fill this year.

Bylaw Change: Move approval of budget from February to November congregational meeting. Motion/Second/Carried Schultz/Crum to approve changing Bylaws to move budget approval from February to November congregational meeting. All voting aye. Meeting set for November 8, 2020.

2021 Budget Approval: Approved above.

Next Council Meeting: Next meeting November 10, 2020.
