Hola from Antigua, Guatemala! Today is Wednesday, March 23. We just got back to our Air BNB after a full day on the jobsite. We grab some snacks and hydration, wash the dust off ourselves, compare notes from the day, and rest.

Our group is building two concrete block homes for two families in the mountains above Antigua. One home will be dedicated to Sam and Jackie Hartmann and the other with thanks to Paul Hartman, who helped us with our barbecue fundraiser. We are all safe and healthy, thanks to the superb care of Pam and Rich Garman.

I am reading a book right now called 'Outliers'. It is about people who become great at something. One of the common factors is 10,000 hours. If you spend 10,000 hours practicing something, you will get really good at it. Pam and Rich stopped counting after 20,000 hours honing this mission trip. They are experts at feeding us, helping us process our experiences, and leading us in navigating the culture.

Yes, our families, selected by From Houses to Homes, are poor, have never seen white people, and live a subsistence living, but this is what they know. Many never leave their little village in the mountains where they grow corn, coffee, cauliflower, strawberries, squash, and the like. Also, the kids are warming up to our groups and smiling more each day.

I am loving all the learning I am doing about masonry, tuck pointing, re-bar, and how hard this work is. Thank you to all the people working in the trades. I am also truly loving learning about the beautiful Guatemalan people.

See you all soon back in Wisconsin, where we will share our experiences.
