Dear OSLC,

I am excited to say that we are interviewing for a new full-time Director of Youth and Family Ministry. We amazingly had 10 applicants apply and have some strongly qualified people to choose from. Some have been doing youth and family ministry for years, some are ELCA seminary trained, and some are excellent at engaging youth through social media. It will be a tough choice. Each candidate brings different gifts that can help our church emerge out of the pandemic with our faith formation ministry.

During the pandemic, we did not restaff the Faith Formation Director job due to the uncertainty of what was happening in the world. We did our best to provide skeleton programming, and hopefully you can have grace for us. But after consultation with the re-booted Learn and Grow Team, they felt strongly that we need someone in this role ASAP. So here we go.

I would consider hiring this position as a leap of faith for the church. Like the Field of Dreams. Build it and they will come. We are not sure how many families want to re-engage in-person with children, youth, and family ministry at the church. But we are going to do everything in our power to be ready to welcome our families back. We trust that through baby steps and word of mouth, this ministry will grow and connect with families at a deeper faith level.

Starting with VBS on August 1-4, we have almost 40 students signed up. We have had a good response of volunteers too. Thank you!

We will be having a congregation fellowship event at the Timber Rattler's game on Sunday, August 14. This is open to all. I will do a pre-game devotion for those who want to participate. Tickets are available at church or through the office.

And "Yes", we will have a Sunday School this year. We will kick this off with a rally day and God's Work Our Hands where people can sign up for Sunday School and join in on some service projects. That will be September 11.

And with our new Youth and Family Ministry person, we will continue confirmation and re-build a youth group that will be about fun, service, and helping our children's ministries.

The Learn and Grow team is currently consulting with Dawn Rundman, a curriculum writer for Augsburg Fortress and Sparkhouse, who will look at our assets and gifts and help us discern our format for Sunday School. We will share more details later.

The Holy Spirit is alive and well in the church. Things are moving and shaking. We will need your support. We will need caring volunteers, we will need people to show up, and we will need financial support.

A Letter From Our Music Director ...

As I write this article, I am preparing for my third weekend as Music Director at Our Savior's Lutheran Church. It has been great meeting and chatting with many of you after our Saturday and Sunday worship services and I look forward to meeting many more of you. Driving home from worship services these past two weekends, I have found myself thinking of the chorus to a song that I haven't thought about in years:

All God's critters got a place in the choir Some sing low, some sing higher Some sing out loud on the telephone wires And some just clap their hands, or paws, or anything they got now

The song "A Place in the Choir" also known as "All God's Critters" or "All God's Creatures" was written by the folk singer Bill Staines and released on his 1979 album *The Whistle of the Jay*. This song has been recorded by many other artists over the years. I first learned this song in Sunday School. I remember many of the kids enjoying all the animals mentioned in the song and some of the animal sounds we would make. I also remember how enthusiastically we all sang. The philosophy behind the song, that we all have the ability to participate in music, also resonated with me at that young age.

I grew up in ELCA churches, singing the liturgy and hymns from the green Lutheran Book of Worship. As a young child, I thought of worship as constant singing. It wasn't until I went to college and spent time working in other Protestant churches that I realized that not all congregations have as much congregational singing as the ELCA churches I had attended. Just singing three hymns, without any liturgy, did not feel like enough congregational singing to me.

I chose to switch to a different setting of the liturgy on the second weekend of July and have had many positive conversations with people about that change and the joy they experience through our worship music. I often say something along the lines of, "I hope my music leadership is helping you lift your voice in song." Some people respond to this saying something like, "You wouldn't want to hear my voice." Although it may be true that you do not want to come up to the piano and sing a solo for me, I do hope to help each of you lift our voices together in worship.
