Update on the Habibi Family

The Omari-Habibi Family continues to learn how to live in Appleton and are doing very well, figuring things out on their own with help from new friends or asking us.

Their relationship with World Relief formally ended July 24 and they no longer receive case management or financial assistance from the agency. They do receive financial assistance, as long as they continue to be eligible, through Workforce Development. Our relationship has not ended, and we continue to have contact with them on a casual basis. We consider them friends and are interested in their welfare and continued adjustment.

At this time the four adults in the family are employed by Goodwill Industries, Plexus Corporation, Partnership Dental and Exquisite Threading. They work a variety of hours and shifts so our face-toface contact has been pretty limited since June.

Subhan (age 10) was going to the Boys and Girls Club at the beginning of summer, but it became difficult for him with the language barrier and all the kids and he decided to end his participation.

They purchased used cars and are experiencing all of the things that go along with that, including car repairs. We learned that cars are a big status symbol for young Afghan men, not that much different from young men in America.

They always say how much they love America and our ways, and they are still very connected to family and friends in Kabul Afghanistan. We hope to have them attend a service at Our Savior's this Fall! Thanks for your continued prayers!
